1. The Secretary of War relieves each of the following-named officers from assignment and duty as indicated and assigns him to permanent station outside the continental limits of the United States, temperate climate, Shipment RE-250. He will proceed without delay from his present station to Camp Reynolds, Greenville, Pennsylvania, reporting upon arrival to the Commanding Officer, to await call of the Commanding General, Caribbean Wing, ATC, West Palm Beach, Fla., for air transportation to destination. Upon arrival at final destination, he will report to the Commanding General for duty.

2. TDN 1-5000 P 431-01, 02, 03, 07, 08 A 0425-24. Travel by military, naval or commercial aircraft, army transport, naval vessel, commercial steamship, belligerent vessel or aircraft, and rail is directed. TD by air from Miami Beach, Fla., to destination is necessary for the accomplishment of an emergency war mission, APR-3-146647-AAF.

3. In lieu of subsistence, a flat per diem of \$7.00 is authorized while traveling by military, naval or commercial aircraft, in accordance with existing law and regulations.

4. A baggage allowance of fifty-five (55) pounds, to include all personal effects, is authorized while traveling by military, naval or commercial aircraft. Baggage, not to exceed 120 pounds, will be marked with the officer's full name, rank, serial number, and shipment number to which he is assigned, and shipped in care of the Port Transportation Officer, Los Angeles Port of Embarkation, Los Angeles, California.

5. Detailed instructions concerning the preparation and movement of individuals are contained in the publication "Preparation for Overseas Movement of Individual Replacements" (PCR) 1 October 1943, which is applicable to this movement. It is highly essential that the provisions of the pamphlet be thoroughly understood and implicitly followed by all concerned.

a. Prior to departure from present station, when practicable, officer will be equipped for extended field service, including clothing (summer and winter) and individual equipment as prescribed in TS #21, 10 March 1943, and Changes thereto. Articles of equipment not available at present station will be obtained at the staging area. In addition, the following items are authorized:

Blanket, wool. CF (2 only per individual)  
Canteens will be stainless steel, plastic or aluminum.

b. Each officer will have in his possession WD, MD, Form 81, showing inoculations and immunizations, including typhus, yellow fever and cholera, yellow fever will have been completed at least two (2) weeks prior to leaving the United States, required before leaving the United States.

6. Each officer should advise his correspondents that mail will be addressed to him as follows:

7. Officer will refrain from discussing the overseas destination of this movement, even by shipment number, as the meaning thereof may later become known by correspondents and the security provided be violated.
